Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made this 20th day of August 2008, between Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab (Government of Punjab) represented by Principal Secretary, Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab (hereinafter referred to as "GOP" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors/representatives), as the First Party.

And

Registrar, Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its representatives, successors, assignees and administrators), as the Second Party.

And

Sh. J.S.Dhaliwal, President, Punjab Un-aided Technical Institutions Association repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include their representatives, successors, assignees and administrators) represented by J.S.Dhaliwal as the Third Party.

Hereinafter collectively called "the Parties"

PREAMBLE

This is a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab (Government of Punjab) and Punjab Un-aided Technical Institutions Association with the objective that the Technical Educational Institutions running undergraduate Degree/ Diploma Programmes in Engineering and Technology, HMCT, Pharmacy, Architecture, Arts and Crafts, should, in addition to sanctioned intake, provide benefit to the various categories of students as specified in the AICTE guidelines dated 9-4-2007.

That the Punjab Unaided Technical Institutions Association shall arrange to have 10+1 and 10+2 science classes in their campuses by utilizing the existing infrastructure available within their campuses and provide science education. This will boost the availability of science candidates at 10+2 level in the State of Punjab.

WHEREAS

1. Government of Punjab wishes to provide benefit of all types of fee and other charges to be waived off in the case of Women candidates, Economically Weaker and Physically Handicapped students getting admission into Degree/Diploma Courses in the disciplines mentioned above.

2. Punjab Un-aided Technical Institutions Association is constitutionally empowered to sign such Memorandum of Understanding.
3. That the Government of Punjab will grant 10% seats in addition to the sanctioned strength of each Institution in the above said disciplines as per the AICTE guidelines.
4. That these 10% additional Seats shall be given to the following categories in the ratio mentioned against each:

A) Women Candidates	33%
B) Economically Weaker	50%
(Annual income of parent/guardian less than Rs. 2.5 lakh from all sources)	
C) Physically Handicapped	17%

(For every group of 60 sanctioned intake, 06 additional seats will be given, which will be allocated in the ratio of 2:3:1 for the above categories. In the event of non availability of students in a specific category as above, the benefit will be given to any other candidate of other categories according to merit).

5. That the fee for these students shall be completely waived off including Tuition fee, institutional charges, Transportation and University funds where the income of the candidate is less than Rs. 2.5 lacs per annum and in all other cases only tuition fee will be waived as prescribed in the AICTE policy. Further, the students admitted under this scheme will also be provided free boarding & lodging subject to availability or provision of funding from Government/Individual or NGO.

6. That the amount of fee and other chargers thus waived off will not be claimed by any institution from the Government or any other authority in any context.
7. That this scheme will be compulsarily followed by all Government Promoted, Private Aided and Private un-aided Institutions from the session 2008-09 onwards.
8. The eligibility for claiming admission under these categories shall be determined by the Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab (Government of Punjab) as per their policy decision and other Government orders notified from time to time.
The monitoring of this scheme will be done by the Directorate of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, Chandigarh.
9. The admission will be carried out as per the AICTE policy guidelines by a committee headed by Deputy Commissioner of the respective district under which the Institution falls and Chairman of the Managing Committee of the Institution.

10. In order to strengthen the hands of the Government in providing education in science stream at 10+2 level in the rural areas of Punjab, Punjab Un-aided Technical Institutions Association shall seek affiliation with PSEB on mutually agreed norms.

The parties here under sign this Memorandum of Understanding as a Token of Agreement for the above provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding.
